Ethics in Decision Making

The decision maker is making ethical decisions because they themselves believe that is the correct course of action. Situational factors appear to be more important at lower-level decisions. In these areas, the decision maker appears to make decisions based on what is expected of them in that situation, rather than on their own values and beliefs.
